# Writing Outcomes for Assessment

What's the difference between Learning Outcomes and Outcomes for Student Success?

Learning Outcomes are what students will take from a specific class or academic program.

Outcomes for Student Success can sometimes look like learning outcomes but can also relate to other types of success that are more experiential.

**Students will use knowledge learned to make career decisions.**

**Students will improve skills related to exposure to center experiences.**

**Students will gain real world experience through internships.**

**Students will gain awareness of mental health issues.**

**Students will make progress towards their degree.**

**Students will be engaged in a campus experience.**
