

Student Worker Requirements to reside at the Agricultural Education and Research Center

1. Student must be a current student. To qualify, the student must be enrolled and registered for class during the current semester. Exceptions include during the winter and summer terms. Students not enrolled in courses in the winter term shall be enrolled in courses during the following spring semester. Likewise, students not enrolled in courses during the summer shall be enrolled in courses the following fall semester. Students must be full time students.
2. Students must be a graduate student in agriculture or an undergraduate student majoring or minoring in agriculture. Graduate students living on the farm will work on the farm regardless of source of assistantship.
3. Student must maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher. If overall GPA falls below 2.5, the student will be given a one semester probationary period to improve the GPA to 2.5 or higher. If overall GPA is still below 2.5 after the probationary period, the student will no longer be allowed to live in AREC housing. Any student that receives a GPA below 2.0 for any semester will not be allowed to live at AREC regardless of his/her overall GPA.
4. Students working at AREC during the summer will have priority on housing at AREC.
5. AREC Housing Committee will review housing applications for students under consideration.
