Donor – A \$10,000 scholarship fund is being established for distribution to students in the School of Teacher Education.

Evaluation Goals – Student success goals were discussed. Department Heads will need to turn in their respective faculty member's goals form to Dr. Evans no later than November 16.

Carry-Forward Funds – Notification will be sent to departments once percentages have been calculated.

Final Grades – Fall semester final grades are due by December 18 at noon. Department Heads were asked to notify full-time and part-time faculty of this deadline.

CPE – They will be visiting campus November 15-16.

Senate Bill 1 – A Common Core training session is scheduled on November 15 at 3:00 p.m. in GRH auditorium. On-line training modules are available for anyone unable to attend the face-to-face session. Part-time faculty who has already completed the training will need to provide a confirmation letter from their principal.

Final Exams – Every fall semester class needs to provide a final exam or meaningful activity to students during the specified final exam schedule.
