The faculty workload study was discussed. It was agreed that the information does not accurately reflect teaching loads, particularly the reductions for other legitimate activities.

The issue is still not settled regarding full-time non-tenure track faculty contracts. Being reviewed is the possibility of continuing contracts that would not require being readvertised.

The food policy was briefly discussed. Also discussed was the response to CPE regarding the impact of budget cuts.

Summer school 2002 stipends were discussed. This information should be communicated to involved faculty.

Brief comments were made concerning the on-line LME program. The new brochures on this program were distributed.

Dr. Evans announced that he has received a promise for a \$800,000 grant with the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards. He also discussed the Praxis pass rate and distributed phone cards from the NBPTS.

Dr. Evans commented briefly on the quality of students in the LME program.

As there was no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
