Dean Evans met with Dr. Caboni on March 29. The following topics were discussed.

Questions:

Advisors –

- 1. How accurate is the data? Several of the faculty/staff advisors listed are no longer working at WKU.

- 3. When and/or how often is the advisor data report pulled?

Grade distributions –

- 1. Where did the students that withdrew from classes go? Did they enroll in other classes, transfer, etc.?
- 2. Is there more specific information needed about the students who are making bad grades and/or withdrawing from classes?

Dr. Norman suggested inviting Tuesdi or other IR staff to Administrative Council to explain the data.

Planning questions from previous Administrative Council meetings will be reviewed at next week's meeting.

Unit heads were asked to review the draft Strategic Plan and think about how we (CEBS) would like to move forward as it relates to attracting and retaining students.

The Student Leadership and Success Committee will be meeting soon to discuss next steps.

Unit heads were asked to send their submissions for the development booklet to Tammy.
