Dr. Sam Evans called the meeting to order at 3:30. There was a Whetstone/Jones motion to approve/second the minutes from the July 14, 2010 meeting and also the minutes from the two electronic votes taken on June 25 and August 6. This motion was approved.

**Office of Teacher Services-CEBS**

Fred Carter presented and made a recommendation to approve. This list was approved.

Dr. Evans informed the Council members that written votes would be taken on all curriculum proposals at today's meeting due to concerns being expressed by some that efforts had been made by individuals to influence the vote on some items.

There was a Whetstone/Love motion to approve/second. Robyn Swanson presented. The motion passed with an 18 yes, 1 no vote.

There was a Stayton/Boman motion to approve/second. Robyn Swanson presented. The motion passed with an 18 yes, 1 no vote.

It was agreed to take 20-22 together as a group.

There was a Croxall/Whetstone motion to approve/second. Robyn Swanson presented. The motion passed an 18 yes, 1 no vote.

### **Department of History (Potter College)**

1. Revise a Program – 111 (major) 017 (minor) Master of Arts in Education History, major or minor

There was a Love/Swanson motion to approve/second. Andrew McMichael presented. The motion passed with a 19 yes vote.

### **Ogden College of Science and Engineering – Department of Geography and Geology**

1. Delete a Course – GEOG 101, Principles of Human Geography

There was a Swanson/McDaniel motion to approve/second. Katie Algeo presented. The motion passed with an 18 yes vote.

## **College of Health and Human Services-Department of Kinesiology, Recreation and Sport**

It was agreed to take items 1-3 together as a group.

1. Create a New Course – PE 507, Sport in Multicultural Society
2. Create a New Course – PE 511, Coaching Theory
3. Create a New Course – PE 512, Administrative Practice in KRS

There was a Whetstone/Croxall motion to approve/second. William Hey presented. There was much discussion regarding critical performance and assessment. It was agreed to remove the wording critical performance on all three proposals and add assessment measures to 3.3. Critical performance refers to assessments incorporated into the accountability system and must be incorporated into all sections of the course.

This motion did pass with revisions with a 15 yes, 4 no vote.

4. Revise a Program – 090, Master of Science in Physical Education

There was a Swanson/Carter motion to approve/second. William Hey presented. There was a great deal of discussion and many suggestions were noted. Level I will be changed to make it clear that students will be completing the Teacher Leader Core courses unless they “test out” of these courses by successfully passing the critical performances associated with the courses. Only then would these students take the PE courses currently listed under Level I. Also, the statement about Professional Learning Communities will be revised to include students interacting with others from other content areas. PEC members also suggested that TCHL 560 be listed under the professional education core to make it clear to students that this is a required course. Sam Evans recommended that the Physical Education representatives meet with Tony Norman to make these necessary revisions. An inquiry was made as to whether REC 543 had ever been approved by the PEC. Dr. Hey did not recall if it had. Therefore, it was removed as a required course in the coaching concentration and replaced with a 3 hour elective course. Dr. Evans indicated that the course could be used for the 3 hours of electives. (After the meeting, it was determined that REC 543 could not be used as an elective.)

After assurances from Physical Education representatives that these revisions would be made, this motion passed with a 16 yes, 2 no vote.

### **Other Business**

#### **▪Diversity Proficiencies Policy**

There was a Carter/Swanson motion to approve/second. Tony Norman presented. The motion passed with a 19 yes vote.

▪Task Force Recommendations to EPSB on Admission and Clinical Experiences were shared. Sam Evans mentioned that it was very likely that the admission gpa would go to 2.75.

▪Information was also shared on a future item regarding certification in Chinese.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 5:10.
