Admission Requirements for Students Educated in

## Required Documents:

### Option 1:

Higher Secondary Certificate/Intermediate Certificate/Senior Secondary School Certificate issued by the appropriate education board - (Or equivalent)

### Option 2:

For early admission only we will accept Secondary School Certificate results and 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, and 11<sup>th</sup> year transcript grades/marks (or equivalent). Higher Secondary or equivalent and documentation are required with minimum academic requirements – once they are completed

### Option 3:

British/Cambridge Curriculum completion documentation (IGCSE/O-levels/A-levels)- see *United Kingdom*

### Option 4:

International Baccalaureate Diploma or H.S. completion documentation from IB curriculum – see International Baccalaureate

## Minimum Academic Requirements:

First Time Freshmen: Applicants must have an overall cumulative grade point average of 2.5 (4.0 scale) in academic subjects at the secondary level.

Transfer: In order to be admitted in good standing applicants must have a GPA of 2.0 (4.0 scale) and be in good standing with previous college/university.
