Required Documents:

Option 1:

External examination results for GCSE/IGCSE (O-levels) **OR** equivalent National benchmark for secondary completion (determined to be appropriate for admission)

- O-Level - Minimum 5 subjects including Core – Language, Math, Science
 - A-Levels can be provided *in addition*

Option 2:

International Baccalaureate Diploma/Completion documentation – see *Intl Baccalaureate*

Minimum Academic Requirements:

First Time Freshmen: Applicants must have an overall cumulative grade point average of 2.5 (4.0 scale) in academic subjects at the secondary level.

Transfer: In order to be admitted in good standing applicants must have a GPA of 2.0 (4.0 scale) and be in good standing with previous college/university.
