Bill 13-22-F. Funding for Off-Campus Recycling Vouchers.

PURPOSE: For the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University to allocate \$405 for off-campus students to receive two months of Recyclops recycling services.

WHEREAS: The money will come from Legislative Discretionary, and

WHEREAS: Students will fill out an application to request the service and fifteen students will be selected to receive residential Recyclops services for November and December 2022, and

WHEREAS: Currently, Recyclops is the only general recycling service available in Bowling Green to off-campus students, and

WHEREAS: Most recycling services end up in a landfill, Recyclops ensures the materials are reused and repurposed. Recyclops services in Bowling Green also takes care of all plastics 1 through 7, and

WHEREAS: While on-campus students have the opportunity to recycle, there is a recycling disparity among off-campus students that this bill can alleviate, and

WHEREAS: In order to preserve the integrity of the post-service survey and avoid conflicts of interest, no current member of the Student Government Association shall apply for these services.

THEREFORE: Be it resolved that the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University will allocate \$405 for Recyclops recycling services,
