Bill 14-17-F. A Bill to Amend the Bylaws of the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University.

**PURPOSE:** For the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University to amend a section for Constitutional Amendment Elections at the end of Spring and Fall semesters to the Bylaws of the Western Kentucky University Student Government Association.

**WHEREAS:** There is no section in the Constitution or Bylaws of the Western Kentucky University Student Government Association to hold specific election times for constitutional amendments, and

**WHEREAS:** To add Section 9 to the Bylaws of Western Kentucky University labeled “Constitutional Amendment Elections” and

**WHEREAS:** To add Section 9.1 to state, “Constitutional Amendment elections shall be held at the end of Fall and Spring semesters, where the majority of the student body must vote to approve the change to the constitution.” and

**WHEREAS:** To add Section 9.2 to state, “All approved amendments to the Constitution of the Student Government Association shall be added to the constitution by the end of the current semester.” and

**WHEREAS:** To amend the current Section 9, regarding Student Government Awards, to now be listed as Section 10.

**THEREFORE:** Be it resolved that the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University amend the Bylaws of the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University to add a section for Constitutional Amendment Elections at the end of Spring and Fall

semesters to the Bylaws of the Western Kentucky University Student  
Government Association.
