Bill 36-17-F. A Bill to Amend the Constitution of the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University.

PURPOSE: For the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University to amend a section for Constitutional Amendment Elections at the end of spring and fall semesters to the Constitution of the Western Kentucky University Student Government Association.

WHEREAS: There is no section in the Constitution of the Western Kentucky University Student Government Association to hold specific election times for constitutional amendments, and

WHEREAS: To add Section 11.2 to the Constitution of Western Kentucky University labeled “Constitutional Amendment Elections” and

WHEREAS: To add Section 11.2.1 to state, “Constitutional Amendment elections shall be held at the end of fall and spring semesters, where the majority of the student body must vote to approve the change to the constitution,” and

WHEREAS: To add Section 11.2.2 to state, “All approved amendments to the Constitution of the Student Government Association shall be added to the constitution by the end of the current semester,” and

THEREFORE: Be it resolved that the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University amend the Constitution of the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University to add a section for Constitutional Amendment Elections at the end of spring and fall semesters to the Constitution of the Western Kentucky University Student Government Association.
