Bill 4-17-F. A Bill to Amend the Constitution of the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University.

PURPOSE: For the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University to amend the Constitution of the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University to require senators to establish and post one (1) office hour per week.

WHEREAS: Section 3.2 of the Constitution will be amended to include Section 3.2.5, which will state "Be able to post a minimum of one (1) set office hour per week," and

WHEREAS: Senators are representatives of the student body and must be accessible, and

WHEREAS: Senators are primarily responsible for the passing of legislation and therefore must be aware of issues facing the student body, and

WHEREAS: Currently the Constitution of the Student Government Association does not require senators to spend any time in the Student Government Association Office, and

WHEREAS: Not fulfilling requirements will result in one (1) absence per time for individual senators, and

WHEREAS: The Judicial Council is responsible for enforcement of the absence policy

THEREFORE: Be it resolved that the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University amend the Constitution of the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University to require senators to establish and post one (1) office hour per week.
