Bill 12-21-F. Funding for 3 of the Spring WKU College Job Fair Scholarships: STEM, Business, and Spring.

PURPOSE: For the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University to allocate \$750 for

the Advising and Career Development Center's spring job fairs.

WHEREAS: The \$750 allocation will come from the Legislative Discretionary fund, and

WHEREAS: As part of SGA's responsibility to better the future of each individual student, this bill would

encourage and incentivize students to show up to the three spring job fairs, and

WHEREAS: The Advising and Career Development Center will be having three spring job fairs which

pertains to STEM in relation to Ogden College, Business in relation to Gordon Ford, and

WHEREAS: The Spring job fair in relation to all majors, but mostly emphasized for liberal art, business,

social science, and health & human services disciplines, and
