

Oral Papers

Oral papers involve delivering one's work in front of an audience. Presenters speak one at a time in a session of about six-eight presentations.

Oral papers are delivered in various ways, ranging from reading a manuscript to delivering an extemporaneous talk, in different disciplines. Oral papers often are accompanied by slides, PowerPoint or Prezi presentations, or other visual aids.

Students will have 10 minutes to present plus 5 minutes for questions for a total of 15 minutes.
